### It Protects You Financially

### It's Required by Law in Most States

Driving without car insurance isn't just risky, it's illegal. Most states require a minimum amount of liability coverage, which helps pay for other people's damages if you're at fault in an accident.

If you get pulled over or in a wreck without insurance, expect:

- Hefty fines
- License suspension
- Possible vehicle impoundment
- Higher premiums down the line



# **KEY TERMS**

Let's decode the lingo so you aren't taken for a ride:

- Premium: What you pay for your insurance, monthly, every 6 months, or annually.
- Deductible: The amount you pay out of pocket before insurance kicks in.
- Liability Coverage: Covers the other person's damages if you're at fault.
- Collision Coverage: Covers your car if you crash into another car or object.
- Comprehensive Coverage: Covers non-crash damage like theft, vandalism, hail, or hitting a deer.
- Uninsured/Underinsured Motorist: Covers
  you if someone else causes an accident and
  doesn't have enough insurance.
- Policy Limit: The max amount your insurance company will pay for a covered claim.



# **DEDUCTIBLES**

A deductible is what you pay out of pocket before insurance helps.

### For example:

If your deductible is \$500 and you cause \$2,000 in damage, you pay \$500 and your insurer pays \$1,500.

- Higher deductible = lower monthly payment, but more out of pocket if something happens
- Lower deductible = higher monthly cost, but less to pay during a claim
- ✓ Choose a deductible you can afford in case of an emergency
